### **Instructors' course**

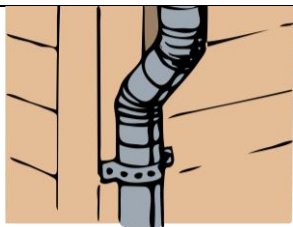
