Archery Australia (AA)

CAMOUFLAGE EQUIPMENT (AA News 1/2015)

For tournaments conducted in Australia it is accepted that camouflage coloured equipment in particular bows are permitted, as they are generally cheaper to purchase than coloured bows and we do not want to disadvantage people. Our rules only restrict the wearing of camouflage clothing. Refer to Archery Australia rule 7.10.7 that states –

The following items of clothing are not permitted:

Clothing with inappropriate or offensive images, slogans or advertising.

Untidy, unclean, damaged or torn clothing.

Camouflage style clothing or clothing intended to break-up a person's image or blend into the bush, such as green or green-based camouflage.

Archery Australia rule 7.10.7 was introduced from a safety point of view and not necessarily from an image or presentation point of view.

Archery Society of Tasmania (AST)– Working with Children Policy

The Archery Society of Tasmania is committed to providing a safe environment for children whilst taking part in archery activities. The Archery Society of Tasmania has formulated a policy that we wish to comply with the Justice Department of Tasmania Working with Children check which comes into force on the 1st of April 2015.

Clubs affiliated with the Archery Society of Tasmania are to ensure all qualified Archery Instructor or above, club president's & club MPO's have a current Working with Children check by the 1st of April 2015

Clubs that are compliant with this policy & the Department of Justice by the 1st of April 2015 can apply to the Archery Society of Tasmania for the reimbursement of the Working With Children check fees for all qualified Archery Instructors &

club president & club MPO's who have applied prior to 1st April 2015.

In consideration of the Department of Justice policy with Working with Children, clubs are also to ensure that club members under the age of 16 cannot be at your range unsupervised. A parent or person cleared by Department of Justice must be present.

Members that have registered prior to the 1st of April 2015 and have been reimbursed their fee are to ensure they remain financial members of AA for the period of their current registration.

After the 1st April 2015 clubs are to ensure any future Instructors/coaches, club presidents & club MPOs are to have a Working with Children check done and the club or member will be responsible for the payment of the fees (for Volunteer Registration the fee is currently \$17.76).
