Shooting at Human or Humanoid Targets

With the current creation of a number of businesses that have arisen that consist of games where Archers shoot at each other the Board feels it is timely to remind all members that **it is against the policies of AA to ever shoot at human, humanoid, zombie, once human or human shaped targets under any circumstances.** The extract below in italics is from the AA Ethical Standards and Practices Policy which is available from the AA website - *TARGETS At all tournaments and Club activities standard target faces should be used. For Target and Indoor standard five colour target faces or recognised variants and for Field standard Black and Gold or Black and White target faces. 3D Archery or the shooting of animal images has become very popular, although Archery Australia does not openly engage in such events RGBs and Clubs may conduct tournaments using this type of target face or butt. Archery Australia discourages the use of Australian Native animals as 3D targets or printed targets. Only feral animal 3D targets or*

printed targets should be used. For special activities and events such as a demonstration or social activities the organisers may use targets as they see fit such a Dart Target, Wand etc but the use of targets that depict human figures, human effigies, humanoids or used-to-be- human silhouettes or any human images are not permitted. The shooting of apples (or similar) off a human head and human head representation is not permitted.
