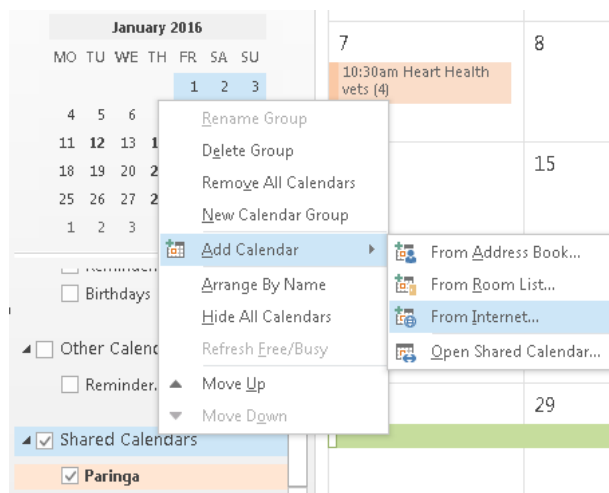

Summary of AST AGM December 2015 for Paringa members

AST currently has 298 members. Two more Chronotir timers capable of matchplay sequences will be bought in 2016 for Huon Archers and Van Diemens Archers, who will commence running registered events.

Scorecards will be returned to archers after competitions for endorsement to claim awards.

A new Rule of the Association was adopted to clarify how Clubs can join and leave AST, and subsequent ownership of any AST assets held.

A ByLaw was amended to link classifications to those currently published by Archery Australia.

The Judges fee at tournaments was increased from \$5 to \$8 to meet the cost of the timing units and provide for a \$25 per diem per judge.

There was discussion about a proposal to change the State Championships to the Matchplay format.

AST is considering altering this from two x 1440 FITA/WA rounds (one per day) to a 1440 round on the Saturday and a trial of a Matchplay tournament with a 720 qualifying round on the Sunday. PLEASE send your support or comments on this proposal to secretary@archerytasmania.org.au.

It was agreed AST will purchase a powerful WiFi base station to facilitate members use of their digital devices for electronic scoring at tournaments.

A requested Calendar change from Paringa was not implemented when it was realised this would place the Northern Championships in the week immediately before the State Target Championships.

Minor changes were made to the executive, with Patrick taking on a vacant Vice-President role and that of Youth Director.

08/2009 AGM 12.2 Tournament State Target, Field and Indoor Tournaments to remain as two days, however, the highest score achieved over one round in each Class will be the winner. Entry Fee is to remain the same whether the participant attends for one day or two days. State Clout to remain as a one-day event. Northern and Southern FITA Star events are at the discretion of the Club hosting the event.
