Sat Come and Try - Range Safety

The Group (Director of Shooting [DOS] and group members) on duty are in charge of the grounds and responsible for making sure that Paringa's facilities are safe for all archers and visitors. For the safety of everyone, the public and members must follow their instructions.

All people on the grounds should use the path for access to the range and not take the shortcut down the drive or straight from the club house. Any animals must be under the control of their owner, preferably restrained, and not running loose.

Temporary members (Come and Try archers) are only insured while under instruction on the Range. Under no circumstances should non-members be on the Field course or Training range unless under direct instruction from a qualified AA Instructor or Coach.

Paringa Indoor Project

Current status is

- confirmation letter received from the Minister Parks and Wildlife (P&W),
- Cyclad confirmed best building site at northern end of range and
- Rolfe making enquiries about proximity to power lines.
- P&W Risk Activity Assessment (RAA) received. Advised it will be a 4 month process.

After this we can start looking at the West Tamar Councils building approval process and fund raising.

Keys

It was decided to use Tas Lock & Key to provide 6 padlocks and 50 'Do Not Copy' keys at a cost of approx. \$1000.

There will be a deposit of \$30 for a club key (waived for current key holders) which will be refunded upon return of the key for anyone not renewing their membership. Shirley M will keep a register of key holders to keep track of who has keys.

Accounts

Treasurer said there was approx \$59k in club accounts with approx \$10k in outstanding expenses so approx \$49k net. So the indoor facility fund is steadily growing.

Indoor Facility

Recent meetings with Parks & Wildlife and West Tamar Council reps have been positive and the application process is underway.

The most likely location for the 'shed' is at the Northern end of the range which will require the range to be extended by 10m at the far end.

Defibrillator

It was decided not to purchase a defibrillator due to the purchase and ongoing costs and the lack of trained people to operate one.

Night Clout Shoots

The possibility of running a few night clout shoots was discussed with a generally positive response. Paul M will arrange a trial shoot sometime after daylight savings finishes.

Accessing Range Saturday Mornings

After discussing the matter of which path to use to get to the shooting line during Saturday Come n Try sessions, members are reminded to please use the top track only so as to set the correct example to members of the public (especially children) who might otherwise pose safety issues if they

start using the direct track onto the shooting lanes.
