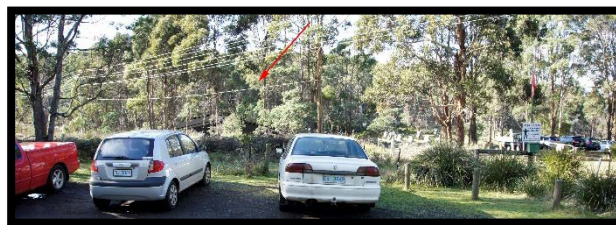
Current status
