**30/04/18** – Major invoices are all in.

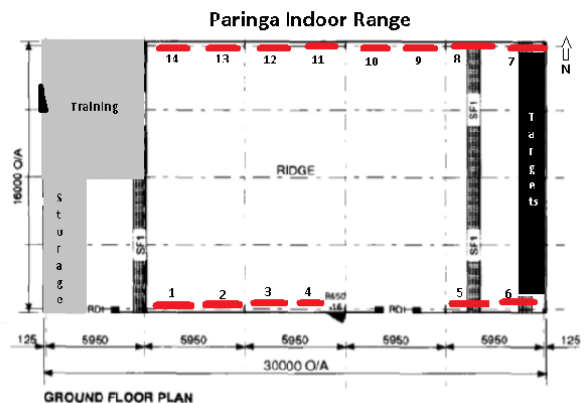
**25/04/18** – 2 x lights added, timer activated and generator filters installed

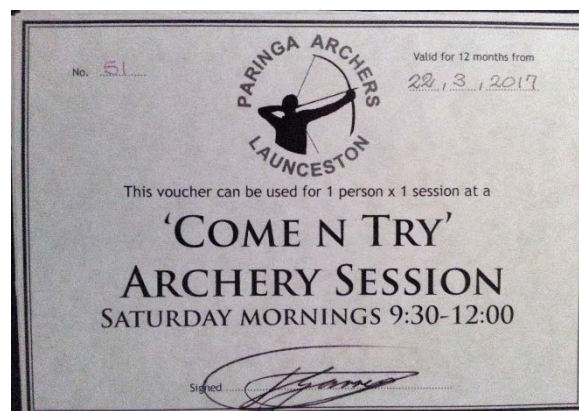
