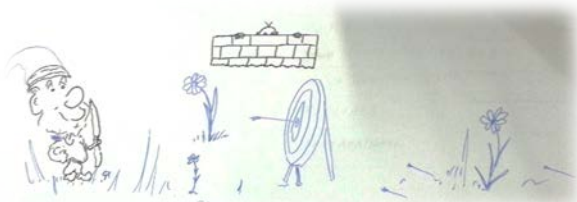

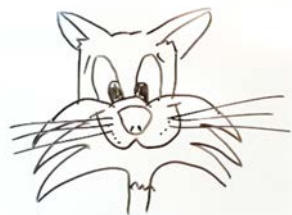

How to Remove Arrows from Timber Butts



It has been noticed that some archers have been using time-consuming and damaging methods of removing arrows from the timber members of the butts.

The following method (or similar) is suggested.



1 – Notice where arrow has opened the wood grain each side of point



2 – Place screwdriver tip on opened grain, close to arrow but not TOO close. You don't want to damage the arrow.

3 – Drive the screwdriver in to depth of arrow point and prise open the wood grain.

4 – Pull arrow while making (careful) circular motions with the arrows shaft to “walk” the arrow out.



5 – The arrow should work its way out with minimal damage to the timber

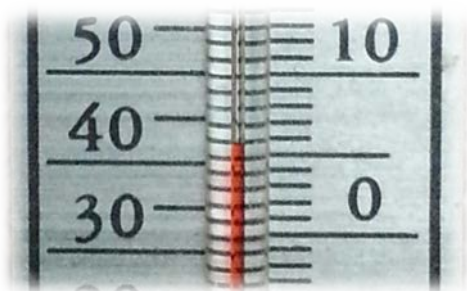

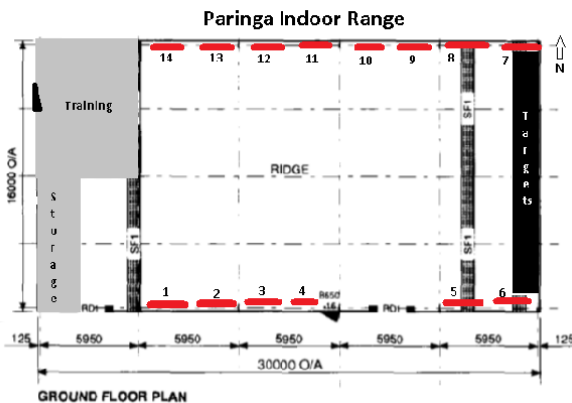

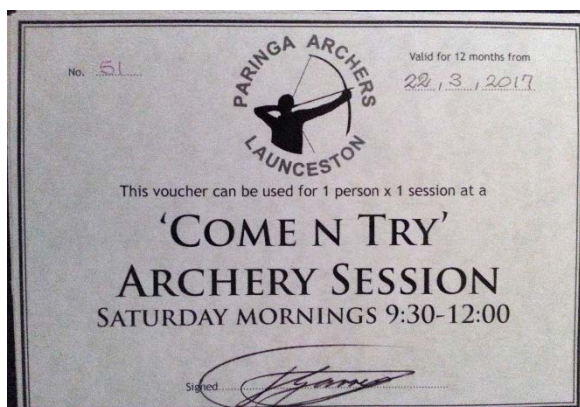
