On Saturday 14th June Paringa held it's Annual General meeting preceded by a Special General meeting.

At the Special General meeting members were asked to forward ideas for the club in 2020 so that the executive committee could benefit from all members' input.

Mall displays were going to be held during the year with the first one on the 18th January. Four members would be needed to man the display and a promotional handout if being prepared for the displays.

The draft handout will be forwarded to all members for their input before the final version is prepared. The brochure is going to be printed in-house as needed, being cheaper than commercial printing.

Annual General Meeting

At the Annual General Meeting the reports were received from the current office holders.

During the treasurers report it was put forward that as agreed to at the last AGM, the membership fees would be increased by the state Consumer Price Index.

The Hobart C.P.I was officially declared to be 2.2% and this was agreed to be the fee increase for the year. This was carried unanimously.

The treasurer, Jeff Garner presented the audited accounts which showed a balance of \$18.6k including the amount of the insurance claim of \$2.6K. Paringa is in a good financial position

The current office bearers were then declared vacant. The minutes of all meetings can be viewed on the Paringa web page.

During the annual general meeting, Brian Swinton was granted Club life membership in recognition for his many years of service to the club and to archery.

During the meeting a 2.2% increase to the Paringa component of the membership in line with the Hobart C.P.I as agreed to the last AGM was approved.

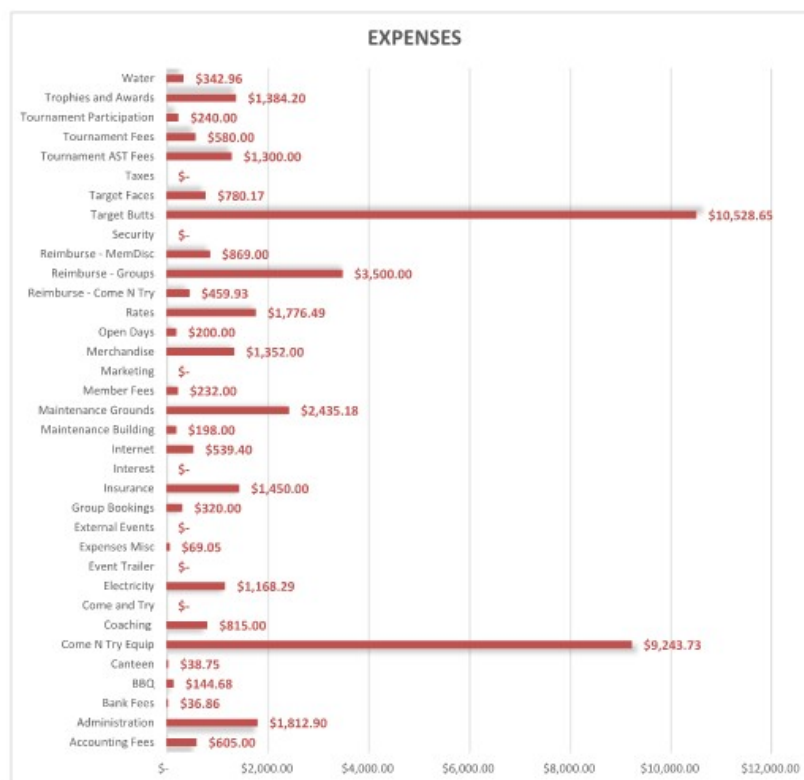

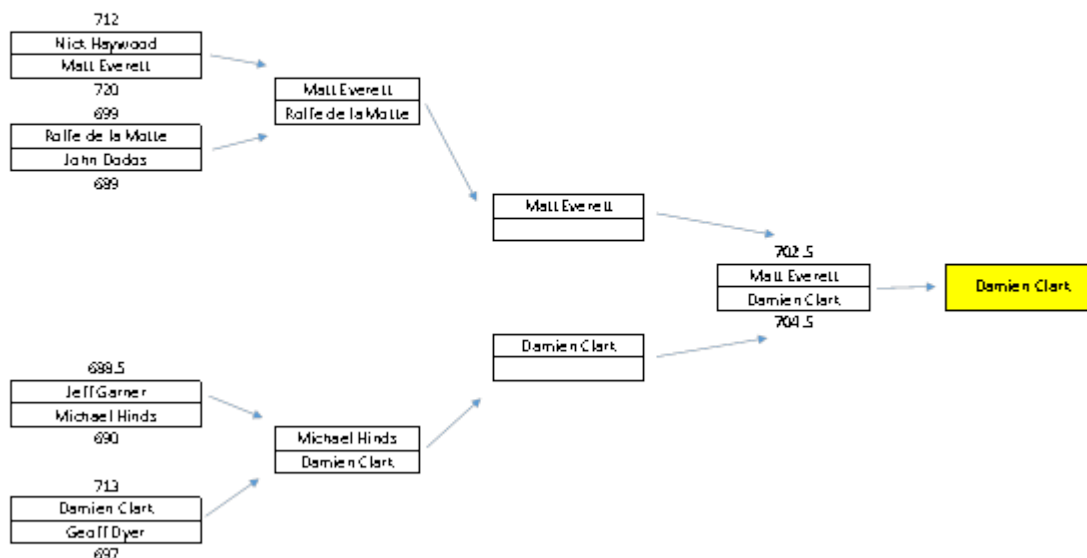

Sunday, for the match play competition, gave us much better weather – still a little windy but nowhere near as bad. In the morning, we had the individual competition which, due to the low numbers, was truly open – male/female and all age classes. The format meant that everybody shot a number of matches, unlike knockout, where you can be knocked out in the first match. No Paringa archers managed to get into the top three.

In the afternoon, a team match play comp was organised. This, again due to the low numbers, was a fully mixed event. Teams of three were put together by the organisers based on scores from the Saturday and consisted of compound, recurve and longbow mixed together. A round robin format was used whereby every team shot against every other team and the results were determined by the team's overall score. James Bramich scored a Silver medal, Geoff Dyer managed a Bronze and everybody had fun.

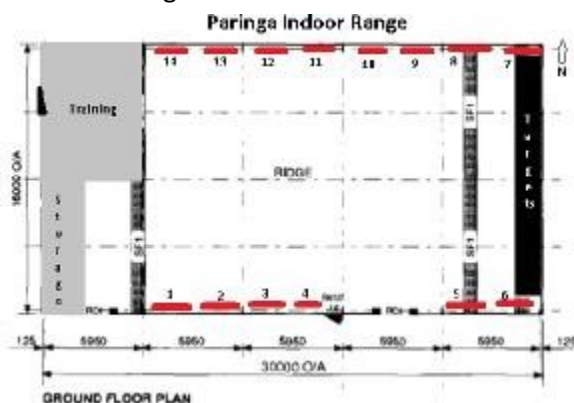

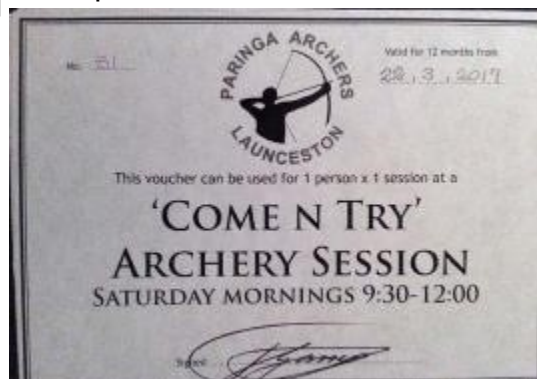
