Paringa Northern Field Tournament 2020

The club held its annual field tournament on the weekend of the 18/19th January. Weather was, as usual, nearly perfect with a southerly breeze keeping the edge off the temperature and blowing the smoke away.

Although attendance was down on the usual, some good scores were achieved. Most notable scores were those of Jay Moylan (VDA) with a 408 on Saturday and 402 on Sunday (maximum score is 432). Jay is trying to qualify for the World Field Champs, this year, and those scores mean that he has achieved the qualifying criteria – selection will be at the Australian Field Open. Matt Everett wasn't that far behind Jay with a 397 on Sunday – I believe that this is his "official" personal best (he has done better in a club shoot). Damian Clark also managed a personal best on Sunday (367) after a day-long tussle with Geoff Dyer who he managed to beat by (only) 1 point. Jeff Garner, being the only recurver, only had himself to compete against and I'm not sure who won..... Everybody had a good, enjoyable weekend and that is what's important, after all.

PARINGA MEMBERS 2020 **BAREBOW** "LAUNCESTON" CHALLENGE



Venue: Paringa Archery Club
Round: Launceston (36 arrows @ 50m + 36 Arrows @ 30m on an 80cm face)
Format: Knockout based on handicaps (not scores)
Entry Fee: \$0 per archer
Prizes: Perpetual Trophy (Donated by Paul Malinowski)
Organiser: Jeff Garner

Entries Close: 5pm Fri 28th February 2020

Rules:

1. Initial matches selected by blind draw.
2. All rounds must be shot by 30/11/2019.
3. Use of a scope or monocular are not permitted for this event.
4. **All bows must be barebow. (longbow, recurve or compound)**
5. Scoring
 - o An independent scorer (agreed by archers) will record both archers nominated handicap before the round
 - o The scorer will score, remove and return arrows to the archers
 - o Archers will not be told their score until completion of the round
 - o Handicap score = score plus handicap
 - o Nearest final score to 720 will be the round winner.
 - If Handicap score > 720 then Final score = $720 - (2 \times (\text{Handicap score} - 720))$
 - If Handicap score ≤ 720 then Final score = Handicap score
 - o Archers may not go past the shooting line before arrows have been returned from a scoring end.
 - o Single scoring with archers and scorer signatures,
 - o Score sheets to be returned to the organiser.
6. Tied scores/matches will be decided by a rematch within the original time limit for matches.
7. Archers must be Paringa and AA member for the whole calendar year of the challenge.
8. Matched archers must shoot the round at the same time.
9. All distances must be shot on the same day.
10. Match may be shot as part of a Club shoot or by the mutual arrangement of matched archers.
11. Archers have 30 days to complete their match from the first date archers are available to compete.
12. Accepted Bow types are Compound, Recurve, Recurve Barebow and Longbow.
13. The Organisers decision on any disputes or rule interpretation will be final.

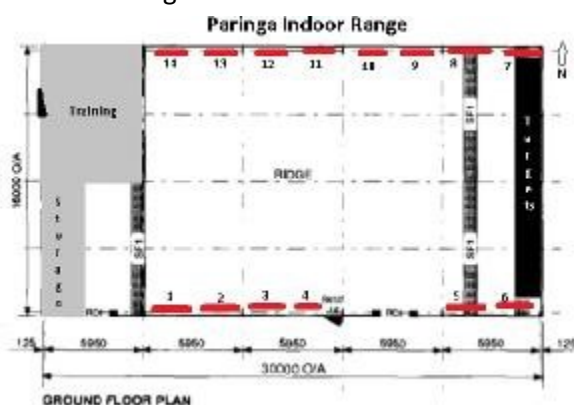
