The Compound High Performance Squad (HPS). The HPS is an Archery Australia initiative set up by Jim Park with the goal of raising the level of compound archery around Australia.

Tasmania is currently one of two HPS programs running (South Australia being the other). I was asked to run the Tasmanian squad and hopefully pass on what I have learned in the sport over my time.

The squad first session was on 23rd February and the squad will get together once a month to refine technique, equipment and mental approach to help each archer closer to their goals.

Archers must have shot a minimum of 660 points for a WA50/720 round in a QRE or tournament and once they have they can apply to join the squad. Currently 14 archers have qualified for the squad.

So you have a few Oz Bow certificates and wonder what's next?

That would be Club Shoots. 1pm Saturday afternoons or 7:30pm Friday nights. See the [club calendar](#) for the

round being shot on a particular day. Descriptions of most rounds can be found in the Indoor range or online [here](#).



On the 7th March 2020 there is a 120 arrow Short Adelaide round. Four distances (50m,40m,30,20m) with 30 arrows at each distance. First two distances on a 122cm face and the last two on an 80cm face.

Don't get hung up on the round, as club shoots are all about learning the ropes and there are also shorter distance club rounds for beginners. Club shoots are held regularly so that members can get used to scoring and recording their results in [Archers Diary](#) (AD). You are also eligible for distance All Gold/Perfect medals, ratings towards classification awards as well as club and state records (AST requirements must be met).

You can turn up at the event and register but it is better to register on [AD](#) beforehand, so that the Club Official running the event has an idea of who is coming.

Competition News

State Field Champs

February 1st saw Hobart hold the State Field Champs. Only one archer from Paringa, Jeff Garner, attended. He only had himself to beat (again) and, so, won the veteran recurve. Conditions on the Saturday were reasonable but the Sunday round was called off half way due to dangerous wind conditions – now that's a surprise in Hobart – not!

Northern WA Star Event

Burnie Bowmen held this year's version of this event (it alternates between us and them) with 1440 rounds giving you the possibility of gaining WA awards or, indeed, world records. There was a slightly disappointing turnout, with only seven entries and only one from Paringa, Jeff Garner again.

Apparently, Saturday had sublime shooting conditions and some good scores were shot, including a state record for Burnie's Trev Rawlings in master compound.

Jeff managed a personal best 1156 with his new recurve bow. Sunday saw conditions more familiar to Burnie (ie windy) and Trev missed out on the double round record by one point – painful!

Target QRE

We had a target QRE on Sunday, 23rd with an excellent turnout of 23 participants. I think that is a record for our QRE's. At least it is for the ones I have run. Most pleasing was the ten Paringa members (plus 3 associate members) who took part.

Attendance was partially boosted by Clint Freeman's high performance clinic, held after the first round. Jay Moylan top scored with 694 putting him in the top ten on national rankings. Trev Rawlings (Burnie) just missed out on a state record (master Compound) by equating the current mark of 668. Highest recurve score was Sarah

Format: Knockout based on handicaps (not scores)

Entries Close: 5pm Fri 28th February 2020

Rules:

1. Initial matches selected by blind draw.
2. All rounds must be shot by 30/11/2019.
3. Use of a scope or monocular are not permitted for this event.
4. **All bows must be barebow. (longbow, recurve or compound)**
5. Scoring
 - o An independent scorer (agreed by archers) will record both archers nominated handicap before the round
 - o The scorer will score, remove and return arrows to the archers
 - o Archers will not be told their score until completion of the round
 - o Handicap score = score plus handicap
 - o Nearest final score to 720 will be the round winner.
 - If Handicap score > 720 then Final score = $720 - (2 \times (\text{Handicap score} - 720))$
 - If Handicap score ≤ 720 then Final score = Handicap score
 - o Archers may not go past the shooting line before arrows have been returned from a scoring end.
 - o Single scoring with archers and scorer signatures,
 - o Score sheets to be returned to the organiser.
6. Tied scores/matches will be decided by a rematch within the original time limit for matches.
7. Archers must be Paringa and AA member for the whole calendar year of the challenge.
8. Matched archers must shoot the round at the same time.
9. All distances must be shot on the same day.
10. Match may be shot as part of a Club shoot or by the mutual arrangement of matched archers.
11. Archers have 30 days to complete their match from the first date archers are available to compete.
12. Accepted Bow types are Compound, Recurve, Recurve Barebow and Longbow.
13. The Organisers decision on any disputes or rule interpretation will be final.

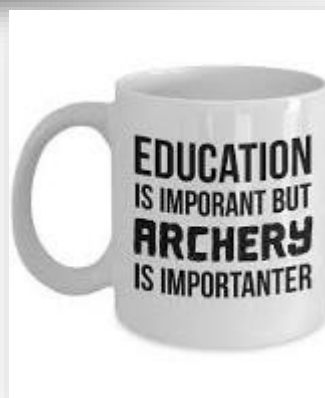

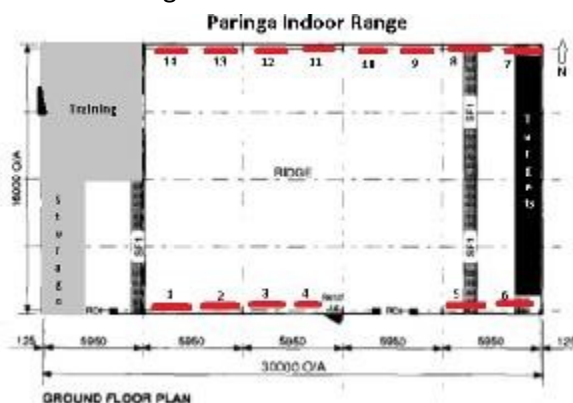
