The above is an interesting photo showing variations in target face resilience following June storms with high winds.

The left face is a competition all-weather face, put on square. The face is generally ok but with one rip at a corner.

Second from left is a paper face put on at an angle and survived well. Right two faces were paper, put on square and ended up shredded.

A message could be that faces put on at an angle seem to fair best.

Another Interesting Photo

Below is a photo from the Hoyt Archery Facebook page, it purports to show the travel of a bowstring using high speed photography. There was a message of caution attached to the photo though. It is a digital image, and the way some high speed shutterless digital cameras process the image onto the sensor is from top to bottom. So, what you are seeing is the image with an extremely short delay. The upper bit of the photo has captured the string just after release and the bottom is a fraction of a second later. It is true that strings do not stop in a dead straight pattern, but the distortion is nowhere near as much as shown in the photo!


