

## Meeting 4/5/15

- External Come n Try events

Following discussion it was agreed that for each event;

1. The first \$100 should go to Paringa Archers for set-up, take-down, supply, maintenance and transportation of equipment

1. The question of acquiring some longer arrows for C&Ts was raised, as too-short arrows could pose a safety risk for taller shooters.

2. With regard to purchasing other equipment eg. bows, ground quivers, arm guards, finger tabs, field butts the treasurer said that the club would wait until August when a grant from the Dept. of Sport & Recreation should become available.

- Stickers

- Indoor Venue

- C&T whistles

Currently C&T DOSs using single whistle blast to begin/end shooting which is at variance with standard competition practice.

Action- R. de la Motte to inform C&T DOSs to use standard format ie. 2 blasts to go to shooting line, 1 blast to commence shooting, 3 blasts to stop shooting and collect arrows

- Beginners courses

Following a very successful but somewhat over-booked beginners course (thanks Caitlin) it was decided to cap numbers at 7 children and 12 adults in future

- Wheels on butts

It was decided to continue putting wheels on target range butts as well as swapping sides of timber frames a couple at a time during small working bees.
