

Problem School Groups

One of the duties for those members when on roster Sat mornings is to ensure that arrows are fixed and ready for use. It is not a hard task for those on duty on Saturdays to inspect arrows returned and to fix any that require it.

The bulk of the Clubs income comes from the School groups that I run during the week. It is not fair to me that I have to fix numerous sets of arrows before I can start a school session as was the case today [23 July] a total of 14 sets

One set requiring 5 of the six arrows needing 1 or 2 fletches. When taking a school session I check and repair any damaged arrows after the session. I should not be required to check and repair all the arrows before the start of a session. If this continues to happen I can see only 2 alternatives open to the club: find someone else to run the school program or stop the school program and triple the membership fees; neither of which I would like to see happen.

But I feel that it is not fair to me that I have to spend so much time fixing equipment before I can start a school session. It is no happy task that I have to write this because I put my heart and soul into making the club the best in the State, and don't want to see that change so I plead with all Saturday roster Groups - please do the right thing. It gives me no joy to have to write this but something has to change.
