Membership	Issues of new member access are arising with the increase in	
	youth interest in the sport. Numbers of enquiries are increasing,	
	which is good, though they are often from younger people	
	already with compound bows. Interest in field course is	
	increasing. Extended discussions were held to consider how we	
	ensure safe practice and ensure new members are good for the	
	integrity of the club.

	Shirley had prepared a written proposed structure to the

	proposed a minimum of four C&T sessions (supported in a	
	written submission by Rolfe), confirmed through attendance	
	records, and the completion of basic training course prior to	
	admittance as a member, with a further three months before

member to toilet facilities. It was also discussed that we don't wish to discourage new members.	
The Archery Basics course that was recently run by Caitlin will be run 4 times a year. This will allow a periodic flow of new members.	
Wayne proposed that a series of compulsory shoot to establish awareness of new members capacities, which was agreed to.	
It was noted that the current key register system is out of date and there are ex members that have retained keys. Geoff Dyer noted that at his previous club, Liverpool NSW, that members waited 3 months before keys were allocated and locks were replaced annually to ensure only current members had access.	
Unanimous agreement (proposed Paul K, 2 nd Jeff) was reached that the club replace all existing locks, and Paul Korosi volunteered to organize a key register and check with Jacksons Locksmiths about DO NOT COPY stamped keys, as registered key were to expensive and inconvenient.	
Jeff propose minor changes to the current new member letter, inserting "Your membership covers only you to undertake Target Archery activities at club facilities 27/7 and does not include archery activities for any 3 rd party (friends, relatives etc)." This was agreed unanimously.	
Discussions covered methods of displaying current membership status, as approaching 'unknown' people to ask to see their membership was challenging. Paul Korosi proposed, with wide support, coloured annual membership cards, but Jeff showed the method to be unworkable with the current AA membership payments structure based on time of payment rather than any annual period. Jeff noted the AA requirement for all shooters to display their current AA membership card at all times.	
Paul Mal suggested displaying AA rules at the range and Paul K agreed to print out a small sign.	
It was noted that legal changes would affect members, including the moves towards 'working with children' certification requirements. AA and club rules members will need such certifications in the future.
