Your Membership Fees at Work

Because someone asked.


As at 27th Feb 2016 Paringa has 53 active members with a total Membership billing of \$12,112 for 12 months.

As an AA member club **we only have control over our portion of the membership fees** and must adhere to Archery Australia (AA) and the Archery Society of Tasmania (AST) constitutions and bylaws. This basically means we are a target archery club and through AA belong to World Archery.

Back to the money.

\$4258 went to AA and **provides Paringa with** Insurance cover for Members, visitors, temp members (Come and Try) and club officials. Among other things, it also means you can show your AA membership card at any club in Australia, pay their daily target fee and shoot. Paringa's target fee is \$2 per day but usually waved on the basis of goodwill and no one is around to collect it. ^(C)

\$2,417 went to AST and **provides Paringa with** State Tournament access, Judges and state based training for officials.



So that leaves Paringa with \$5,437 (44.89%) to run the club. \$2034 was allocated to Administration (spent \$3, 751.62) and \$3,403 was allocated to Targets (spent \$2096). Yes we over spent by \$400.62 based on allocations.

Luckily our budget includes other activities like the canteen, Sat Come and Try, External events, weekday groups and contributed time with working bees.

So if we didn't have members volunteering to run these activities, the club would still be operational but in a slow spiral of decline having no excess working capital for improvements.

When I look around the grounds and see the club house, range and field course I certainly appreciate the great effort others have made in the past to get the club on the footing it is today. Hopefully the next generation will feel the same about our contribution.

Paringa Indoor Project

Friday 5th Feb Rolfe (President) and I had a meeting with Alana Fazackerley, Sport and Rec, to convey our intention to apply for a major grant (\$80k) for the Indoor Range. Alana advised the project appeared to meet grant criteria and spoke about the timeline and documentation (Business Plan etc) required.

Rolfe and I had a meeting, at the club, with Chris Price, Leesa Grundy, Robert Buck, Adam Smith (Parks and Wildlife), Kaitlin Roach and Michael Purves (West Tamar Council) on **Tuesday 23rd Feb**. Action items were that Parks and Wildlife, as Leasee, would confirm Ministers approval to build the Indoor Range subject to the successful completion of a Reserve Activity Assessment (RAA). Three preferred sites were inspected and discussed.

Rolfe and I met with Dave Keller from Cyclad Building and Fencing on **Friday 26th Feb** to discuss the best location for the shed. It was agreed that Parks and Wildlife's preferred location, at the northern end of the range, was also Cyclad preferred location. Dave will confirm this with his concreter. As an aside, they are also building the Rangers new shed just down the road.

Current status is

• waiting for confirmation letter from the Minister Parks and Wildlife,

- waiting for Cyclad confirmation of best building site and
- Rolfe making enquiries about proximity to power lines.

After this we can start looking at the RAA, West Tamar Councils building approval process and fund raising.

The Final Say

The club has a natural feed in process for potential members.

We start with building awareness through external events, week day groups and Sat Come & Try sessions.

If people find archery is a sport they want to pursue then the four session Beginners Course is the next step that prepares them with the basic skills and knowledge for membership.

To put this into perspective, over the last two years the club has had 7,000 visitors trying archery, of these we have gained 38 new members.

That is a .5% conversion rate. Having talked with other clubs and AA representatives this is not unusual at the club level.

With a total PAC membership of 53 from a possible 140,000 residence in Northern Tas we have a .039% uptake. PAC is doing about the same as Archery Aust with 8,000 members for a population of 24mil (.033%). Could we do better?
