### Coaching

So how do we improve our performance/scores?

Performance = Bow Setup X Form X Head Space.

Okay it's not that simple but by focusing on these three area you can incrementally improve your performance.

The table below shows how many degrees off centre shot it takes to miss the different sized targets at various competition distances. Ie: At 90m on a 122cm target you only have to be .39 degrees off centre to miss the face (5mm off at the tip of a 29" arrow) and from the table, this is close in degrees of difficulty to a 40cm target at 30m.

This information allows us to practice for **form** by shooting on a 40cm face at 30m rather than collecting arrows at 90m on a 122cm face.

So if you can keep within the red on the 40cm face at 30m then it is only your **bow setup** and **head space** that will prevent you from staying in the red at 90m on a 122cm face.

This of course doesn't take into account those "small" variations you may encounter like the weather.

### **Dress Standards**

Every now and then judges are drawn into a discussion about dress standards at tournaments. Both FITA (3.22 – these are for major international events) and AA (7.10 for Archery Australia events) have dress regulations, that need to be adhered to. However, 7.10.4 (AA Rules) stipulates very clearly that it is the responsibility of the Organising Committee to enforce dress regulations and take appropriate action if needed. It is not the responsibility of the judges for national or RGB events.
